

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
WESTERN CAROLINA REGIONAL SEWER AUTHORITY
PROPOSED ADDITIONS AND AMENDMENTS TO THE SEWER USE
REGULATION**

Notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be held before Western Carolina Regional Sewer Authority (WCRSA) at 9:00 A.M. on Wednesday, the 16th day of April, 2008. Written comment may be received through April 25th, 2008. The hearing will be held at the office of WCRSA, which is located at 575 Mauldin Road, Greenville, South Carolina. The purpose of the public hearing is to receive public comment regarding proposed revisions to the Sewer Use and Pretreatment Regulation. The Regulation establishes purpose and policy to regulate the use of public sewers. Revisions include modifications to Sections 1, 2, and 4. The proposed Sewer Use Regulation update addresses pump station ownership, development in areas not covered by a public provider, and codifying the memorandum of understanding on the Babbitt Equation. The purpose of this document is to ensure the integrity of the collection systems for the benefit of the communities we all serve.
